








ISPAH BOARD ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURE













Administrative support

- In 2022, ISPAH established an agreement with Venue West to provide support with:
 - o Financial matters (invoices, accounting, tax returns) and country registration
 - Organization of the ISPAH Congress for Paris 2024, Mexico City 2026 and 2028
- We learned, over 2022-2023 that:
 - Banking in Canada is challenging
 - Many day-to-day operations are more easily managed internally
 - There are huge advantages in working with a local Congress organiser
- We terminated our agreement with Venue West and worked with Overcome to organise Paris 2024
- We will work with a local Congress organiser for Mexico City 2026 and 2028
- We are currently assessing options for external administrative support vs internal management

Finance Report **Dr Gemma Ryde**







- For the 1st time, ISPAH has taken on the financial risk of delivering the biennial Congress -If the event 'breaks even' ISPAH will have \$92k to cover initial payments for Mexico 2026 e.g. Venue deposit
- Established Non-for-profit status in Canada
- Established new bank account
- Increased transparency and efficiency of tax reporting and accounting
- Over the next year ISPAH will move to the right balance of control over finances whilst complying with legislative responsibilities

ISPAH by-laws

- For clarity and consistency, we propose to standardise ISPAH Board role titles. All portfolios will have a designated 'Lead' (EG Governance Lead, IT Systems Lead). Executive Committee titles and the Secretariat will remain unchanged.
- Management of ISPAH's IT infrastructure will be undertaken by the 'IT Committee', overseen by the 'IT Systems Lead'. The IT Committee will fulfil all tasks previously handled by the 'IT Systems Director' and 'IT Operations Director'.






Advocacy Report

- Developed an ISPAH workplan template
- ISPAH identified need to upskill members in PA advocacy, and we explored the potential for an online training course:
 - o **Objective** to upskill individuals in: (i) fundamentals of effective advocacy, (ii) how to take on an advocacy role, (iii) formulate advocacy objectives and (iv) apply advocacy models to develop advocacy strategies
- Online ISPAH member advocacy survey was positive, but low completion rate (n=10)
- Collaboration with ISCA to update existing / develop new advocacy training course, ongoing meetings for planning purposes
- Online training tool framework underway for launch Nov/Dec 2025

 - 3 held since November 2023 with each ~ 15 participants

- Financial security to underwrite Mexico City 2026












Number of presentation abstracts submitted by lead author country of residence

ISPAH membership survey

- Survey circulated in May-June 2023
 - o 74 respondents, mostly from high-income countries
- Most valuable activities: free access and discounted rates for open access publications in JPAH,
 ISPAH Congress discounts, scholarships for LMICs, education activities, networking, research
 collaboration, access to ISPAH councils and regional networks, and exclusive access to the
 members' area of the ISPAH website and directory
- Recommendations:
 - Foster involvement in ISPAH Councils by organizing more networking events, webinars, and workshops
 - Facilitate connections/networking and provide support for members seeking collaborations with researchers and organizations from different countries
 - Strengthen global mentoring initiatives to ensure long-term engagement, support, and accessibility, fostering lasting connections within the physical activity community








Low and Middle Income Countries (LMIC) Research Council

- 2 x Dragon's Den events: An online platform for early-career researchers in the Global South to pitch research ideas and receive collegiate feedback and mentoring
- Delphi Study: An initiative to support the prescription of physical activity in the **Global South**
- Health Economic Evaluation Hub and Clinics: The setup process is currently underway













Council for the Environment and **Physical Activity (CEPA)**

- CEPA continues to have a strong emphasis on facilitating multi-national research collaborations
- CEPA operates with a structure of "working groups"; the most active working group over the past 4 years has been the policy workgroup, led by Prof. Billie Giles-Corti, leading to the launch of the Global Observatory of Healthy and Sustainable Cities (GOHSC) initiative, including its 1000 Cities Challenge
- CEPA is currently seeking to strengthen the operating structure and leadership:
 - Seeking the next Chair
 - Identifying themes that better fit today's key research streams within the field of physical activity and the environment









Epidemiology Council

- PACE the Physical Activity Cohort Repository brings together a central database of cohort studies that have prospectively collected data on physical activity and/or sedentary behaviour (self-report and/or device-based measurement) at two or more timepoints.
 - The protocol for the study has been published. A website where users can search for different cohort studies with physical activity data has been developed.
- Confounder selection project aims to understand how confounders are selected for analysis of observational epidemiology studies, given the critical importance of confounding selection for model adjustment and eventual inference about physical activity-outcome associations.
 - A team of council members have contributed to data extraction and review. A manuscript is being prepared for publication.

ECR mentoring workshop

Hosted 3 sedentary behaviour webinars:

- Measurements and Analysis of Sedentary Behaviour
- Building an International Database on Sedentary Behaviours
- International recommendations for School Related Sedentary Behaviours

Ongoing SBC member's systematic review:

- o TITLE: Quantity and patterns of sedentary behaviours in people living with a chronic condition: A systematic review
- Full text screening complete for seven chronic conditions areas. Data extraction ongoing
- 20 members working on the project from 18 countries

Hosted a 3-day series educational workshop:

Sedentary behaviour data collected by the activPAL: How to clean and process data







